

Release Policy

The Pelham Raiders Minor Lacrosse Association (PRMLA) policy regarding player releases is detailed below. This policy must be used in all cases where a player wishes to be released from the PRMLA (their home association), in order to sign and play with another association. PRMLA has a fundamental commitment to the growth and development of PRMLA and the game of lacrosse. PRMLA has adopted a 'no release' policy for players residing within the territorial boundaries. PRMLA does not want to hinder the development of any player, so exceptions for the release of individual players to programs in other centres will be considered by a special meeting of the Board in circumstances when such programs are not available in PRMLA.

POLICY:

1. A letter is to be sent to the Rep Director, outlining the request for release and the reason PRMLA may be able to address to prevent future difficulties. Also, the applicant is required to complete section one (Parent/Guardian/Player) on the Ontario Lacrosse Association's (OLA) Release Request Form – Box and submit the form to the PRMLA along with a \$25 non-fundable player release fee. If release is granted, your registration amount minus a \$75 administration fee.
2. A request for a player release will only be accepted once the player is registered with PRMLA for the current season, including paying all dues and fees, including the \$25 cash player release fee.
3. The Executive committee of the PRMLA will respond to the applicant within seventy-two (72) hours of receiving the formal request, and once confirming all fees and dues are paid with either the approved release or a date when the release meeting will be held, along with the time and location. This process will allow the applicant to discuss the request.
4. If the PRMLA denies the request, the PRMLA will return the OLA form with section two (Lacrosse Club) completed with written reasons for denying the request. If you wish to appeal the decision it is up to you to contact the zone for the proper appeal process.
